

ORDINANCE 2011-11199

**AN ORDINANCE OF NEWBURG BOROUGH, CUMBERLAND COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA,
AUTHORIZING, APPROVING AND ADOPTING AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL COOPERATION AGREEMENT
WITH NORTH NEWTON TOWNSHIP, CUMBERLAND COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA,
FOR SIGN MAINTENANCE AND SERVICE WITHIN THE BOROUGH OF NEWBURG**

WHEREAS, Newburg Borough has the authority pursuant to the Intergovernmental Cooperation Act, 53 Pa.C.S.A. §2301 et seq., to enter into intergovernmental agreements with other political subdivisions, in accordance with existing laws, in performing governmental powers and duties and functions and in carrying into effect provisions of law relating to subjects which are common to such political subdivisions; and

WHEREAS, Newburg Borough desires to enter into an Intermunicipal Agreement with North Newton Township wherein North Newton Township will provide to the Borough of Newburg certain sign maintenance services as needed by the Borough of Newburg; and,

WHEREAS, Newburg Borough believes that it is in the best interest of its citizens to adopt this Ordinance ratifying the Intermunicipal Agreement with North Newton Township.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED and it is hereby adopted by the Newburg Borough Council as follows:

SECTION 1:

The preamble recited above is incorporated by reference herein.

SECTION 2:

Newburg Borough shall enter into the Intermunicipal Agreement with North Newton Township to permit North Newton Township to perform certain road sign maintenance within the Borough of Newburg at the request of the Borough of Newburg and such services will be paid for by the Borough of Newburg in accordance with the rate schedule attached to the aforesaid Intermunicipal Agreement.

SECTION 3:

The President of Borough Council is authorized and directed to execute all documents and to do all other acts as may be necessary and proper to carry out this Ordinance and the undertaking of this Borough.

SECTION 4:

The initial term of the Agreement shall be for a period of one year to commence upon execution of the Agreement and may be renewed annually thereafter by the parties.

SECTION 5:

All other ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are expressly repealed.

SECTION 6:

In the event that any provision, section, sentence, clause or portion of this Ordinance shall be held to be invalid, such invalidity shall not affect or impair any remaining provision, section, sentence, clause or portion of this Ordinance, it being the intent that such remainder shall be and shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 7:

It is declared that enactment of this Ordinance is necessary for the protection, benefits and preservation of the health, safety and welfare of the inhabitants of this Borough.

SECTION 8:

This Ordinance shall take effect immediately.


